Course Syllabus

What is a Syllabus?

The syllabus is usually defined as the document distributed by the instructor of a course to students in a course at the beginning of a semester, outlining the work of the course for the semester.

• When created with intentionality, a syllabus serves as an invitation to connect the student to the professor, other students, and the course!

A syllabus contains information such as:

- > Faculty & department contact information
- ➤ Faculty office hours
- Course description and objectives
- ➤ Student Learning Outcomes & Expectations
- ➤ Required texts and reading materials
- ➤ Grading and assignment policies, etc.

- Learn about why they do what they do mentors, role-models, etc.


